Welcome to the Charger Nation! We are virtually ready for anything! Suncoast High School is excited to start the 2020 – 2021 school year after many months of planning and preparing for this new adventure. We would like you to take note of the information communicated in this Charger Update for planning purposes. The Charger Update will be released at the end of each week to keep you informed.

The philosophy of the "Suncoast Virtual Experience" is to conduct classes according to our traditional block period schedule in a virtual environment. Our teachers will take attendance, facilitate live lessons, post assignments, provide descriptive feedback, and assess student performance using the *Google Classroom* platform. With careful planning, our School District has developed systems to monitor academic performance and increased attention to student well-being. Students will receive Google Classroom codes, aligned to their schedules, in future correspondence. Bright Futures Updates: Changes were made to the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program during the 2020 Florida Legislative Session as a result of <u>Senate Bill (SB) 72</u>.

- Florida Academic Scholars (FAS): Beginning with the 2020-2021 fiscal year, the additional \$300 per term stipend for textbooks will be specified in the General Appropriations Act (GAA) rather than specified in Florida Statutes.
- Florida Medallion Scholars (FMS): Beginning with the fall 2021 term, FMS recipients enrolled in an associate degree program at a Florida College System institution may be eligible to receive an award equal to 100 percent of tuition and specific fees.

IN THE COMMUNITY

Community Meal Program: The last day of the summer *Grab & Go* feeding program will be **August 27**, **2020**. On September 1, all schools will participate in the *School Breakfast Program* (SBP) and the *National School Lunch Program* (NSLP). **All Palm Beach County students** will be sent, via email, a welcome back letter that will contain their personal barcode. Parents will have to present this letter or have the full student number when picking up meals. Students' numbers or barcodes will be captured into a Point of Sale at the pick-up line. This is similar to the way students came through the school cafeteria line in the past; however, **all meals will be distributed curb side**.

Students do not need to attend school at the food distribution location to pick up meals. **Meals will only be given to students with an assigned Palm Beach County student number.** Lunch prices will be charged to students' accounts according to their benefit status; for this reason, online prepayments are recommended. If additional meals are picked up at other sites for the same student, a la cart charges will appear in the student's account.

Serving times will be 11:00 am - 1:00 pm and 3:00 pm - 5:00 pm, every Tuesday and Thursday.
